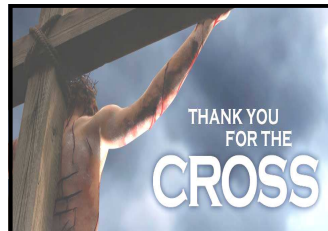

HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Read **2 Corinthians 11:16-12:10**. Paul continues responding to the accusations of the "Super Apostles" who are attempting to take credit for his work. Have you ever found yourself in a similar situation? How did you respond?
- Discuss as a group what you believe Paul feared for the Corinthian Church, if they continued to be influenced by the "Super Apostles"? (**2 Cor. 11:20**)
- What would you consider your own weakness to be? Have you viewed it as something to hide or do you consider how God could use it to show His power to others?
- Why is it so hard to embrace, let alone boast about, our weaknesses? What have the challenges of this past year revealed to you about the way you look at your own weaknesses?
- How do you feel about God refusing to take away Paul's thorn? Read **Matthew 26:39-46**. How does that passage broaden our understanding of God's power made perfect in weakness?
- Read **2 Corinthians 10:12-18**. What kind of boasting did Paul allow himself? How does that challenge you personally?
