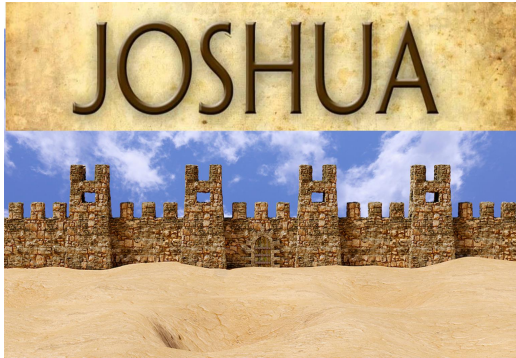

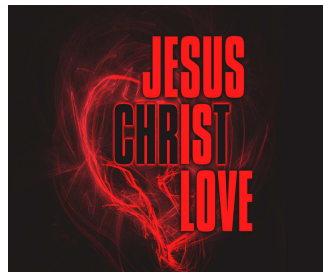

Do You Remember?

The story of the Crossing of the Jordan River by the Israelites in Joshua 4 helps us answer some important questions:

1. How can we remember what God has done?
2. Why should we remember what God has done?

HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Share a memory of a person, place or thing that makes you smile when you remember it. How is that memory important to you?
- Read **Joshua 4:1-9**. Why 12 stones? Why 2 different memorials?
- Read **Joshua 4:21-24**. What specific points does Joshua make when he speaks these words? What aspects of the event does he want the people to pass on to their children?
- Memorials are symbols or items used to remember an event or a person. Do you have any memorials in your life? Has anyone ever asked you about one of your memorials?
- Can you remember a specific time in your life when God revealed Himself to you in a significant way? What was that like? Is it easy or difficult to remember that experience?
- God revealed Himself to the nation of Israel in preparation for the big task ahead of them. Is there something that God wants you to do or say that would be easier if you were convinced that He is with you? Does remembering how He has worked in your life in the past give you confidence to trust Him with what He wants you to do or say?
- Spend some time praying for one another – that each of you would be able to trust God for what lies ahead because you remember what He has done in the past.
