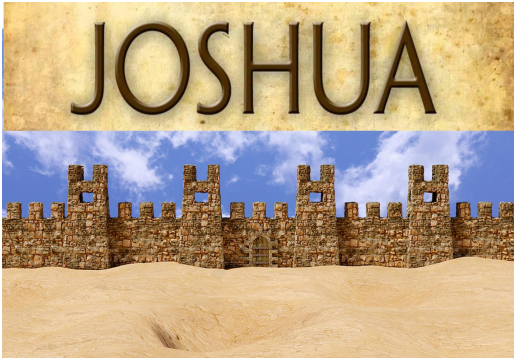

HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- ICEBREAKER— If you had to eat one meal for the rest of your life what would it be?
- What rite of passage marked your coming of age into adulthood?
- Read **Joshua 5:1**— Why do you think the kings were so afraid? What spiritual lesson might this teach us?
- Read **Joshua 5:2-8**. Why was it so important to God that all the men be circumcised? What event or ceremony reminds you of your commitment to follow Christ?
- Read **Joshua 5:10-12**. What stands out to you in these verses? Why do you think they hadn't celebrated Passover for nearly 40 years? Why now?
- When you hear the phrase, "Consecration before Conquest" what does that mean for your life? How does **Romans 12:1-2** fit into all this for us?
- Read **Joshua 5:13-15**. Many believe this man was a "Theophany" or "Christophany" How might the text confirm this? Why do you think this encounter happened?
- What is one area of your life you need to consecrate yourself before moving forward?
